We are also Alpaca owners and use our Alpacas in our Behavioral Resolution Programs that help challenging children work through their behavior conflicts. We use the fiber in our fiber arts programs with young children and adults. The fiber is used for felting which will also be incorporated into designs of felted pieces which will help support our programs of enhancing the quality of children and adult's lives.

Your donation of fiber will not only help with our programs but your donation will be tax deductible. Doing some rough math here, a donation of say 10 pounds of unwanted fiber could net you a tax credit of \$400.00 or more! \$400.00 for fiber that would otherwise be worth little. You can donate whatever extra fiber you may have too.

All you have to do is bag up the fiber. We will pick it up, weigh it, and give you a letter thanking you for your donation of x amount of dollars worth of fiber to our non profit.
